



Fluorescent & HID Lamp Recycling

EPSI can recycle any fluorescent or HID lamp regardless of whether the lamp tests hazardous. Recycling separates the toxic substances (such as mercury) from the glass, aluminum, and other components. All materials may be reused in manufacturing other products.

PCB Ballast Recycling

EPSI removes the PCB-containing materials (i.e., the capacitor and asphalt potting material surrounding the capacitor) for incineration or land disposal. Metals, such as copper and steel, are reclaimed from the ballasts for use in manufacturing other products. NON-PCB ballasts may be recycled.
