The assessment will be based on information obtained from the offeror’s proposal, Government Agencies, and may also include information obtained from the offeror’s commercial customers.”

Page 43, Paragraph 1.0 Price – Dynamic Pricing Event is clarified as follows: The date for the Dynamic Pricing Event (DPE) will be determined after receipt of offers. This DPE/on-line reverse auction will be conducted with offerors determined to be in the competitive range for this acquisition. The time periods specified in paragraph 1.2, “During the Dynamic Pricing Event”, will also be determined after receipt of offers. All pertinent information will be disseminated to responsive offerors with adequate time to prepare for the DPE.
