Here's the latest STORES news -

Department of Defense Architecture Framework Documents (DoDAF)

The DoDAF diagrams are now in place. These documents are a requirement for Milestone B approval. Examples of DoDAF diagrams include operational, system, and technical views of the Common Food Management System (CFMS). These views detail how CFMS will interface with other applications, how data flows within the system, etc.

The Test and Evaluation Master Plan (TEMP)

DSCP submitted the TEMP to DLA Headquarters. The TEMP details the tests to be performed to ensure that CFMS satisfies our functional requirements.

System Security Authorization and Accreditation (SSAA)

The SSAA document is now in the review process. The SSAA explains how CFMS satisfies information assurance requirements. A signed, approved SSAA document is required before CFMS deployment at any location. The information assurance process is very complicated, and it's a process started early in the Program, to make certain information assurance is incorporated into the system.
