Contract SP0300-01-D-2932 is hereby modified as follows:

The Defense Supply Center Philadelphia has partnered with the U.S. Department of Agriculture Food and Nutrition Service Team and Reinhart Institutional Foods, Inc. to support 23 Native American Indian Tribes located across three states – Michigan, Wisconsin and Minnesota.

Section B: SUPPLIES AND SERVICES

The following delivery points are added to prime vendor contract SP0300-01-D-2932: See attachment 1 – Delivery Schedule.

In order to accommodate SPVI system requirements, contract SP0300-01-D-2932 for this pilot test portion of the contract is changed to read: SP0300-01-D-3011. As of July 1, 2001, all correspondence for the USDA/Indian Tribal Organization customer's invoices, 832's, etc. must reflect the new contract number **SP0300-01-D-3011**.

Section C: Description/Specification

Ordering for supplies under this contract shall be performed by the ordering activity via Stores on the Web.

Section E: Inspection and Acceptance

Inspection and acceptance of products will be performed at destination. Each Indian Tribal Organization ordering facility will be responsible for accepting or rejecting products as required. All food items must be inspected for count, condition, and identity and approved by the ordering activities authorized personnel receiving the delivery before final acceptance can be made.
