Once product is tri-walled and dispatched the order is treated as filled and cannot be cancelled.

In addition to pricing, performance is as stated:

1. PWC Qatar will take receipt of orders designated for airlift
2. PWC will coordinate with the USAF POC for the delivery time and destination.
3. PWC will receive ordered products and load them in the appropriate tri-walls.
4. Tri-walls will be constructed from the appropriate level of cardboard to withstand the normal requirements of the journey. Frozen or chilled item tri-walls will be lined with suitable insulating materials and either wet ice or dry ice will be added as appropriate to maintain the products for the expected journey timeframes. Pallets are included.
5. PWC will coordinate with the respective military service health inspector and any other appropriate coordinator for any inspection of the products and their satisfactory packaging.
6. PWC will make delivery to Al-Udeid in sufficient time to clear security and off-load at the designated location.
7. Once product is received and accepted at the point of delivery PWC shall not be responsible for the deterioration of goods in transit to the final destination.
