1. The purpose of this modification is to formalize the distribution fee changes required in respect to the first evaluated quarter under this contract for the purpose of the performance based distribution fee (PBDF,) provision. The quarter was based on the period from 29 June through 04 Oct 03, as definitized in modification P00007.
2. Based on Japan's actual quarterly fill rate of 95.3% for the period, a distribution fee reduction of 10% of the distribution fees is required at this time, since this achieved performance fails to meet the target range of 97.5-98.5% inclusive. This will apply throughout the second quarter which runs from 05 Oct 03 and end on 03 Jan 04.
3. For Singapore and Diego Garcia, the standard distribution fees continue to apply. The overall fill rate for Singapore for the first quarter is 96.4%. Although this falls below the performance target, this was caused by an influx of orders representing ordering quantity variations beyond a surge level (above 300% increase) thus relieving the vendor from some of the potential consequences of the clause. In the case of Diego Garcia, although the overall fill rate for the first quarter is 91.8% the customer order lead time has consistently been significantly less than the 52 days which are required for this zone, which also waives the potential for a distribution fee reduction.
4. The third quarter will run from 04 Jan 04 through 03 Apr 04. The vendor is required to enact any necessary changes to the distribution fee based on the PBDF provision via 832 changes by the second weekend following the end of the quarter.
